

Have fun with this easy to complete and creative treat holder. This makes a great table centerpiece for just about any occasion!

What you will need

- 1 clean TP tube
- 1/2 sheet white printer paper
- 4 inch orange pipe cleaner
- 2 google eyes
- Sharpie
- 3 small black pom pons
- 2 white pom pons
- 2 thin sticks
- 3-5 leaf stems
- Glitter
- Glue Pen
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun
- Candy

Let's get creative

Note: Adult supervision is needed when using scissors and hot glue gun.

Cut a 5.5 inch square of white paper out of a half sheet and wrap around the TP tube with one side lined up to the top edge. Glue to the tube and tuck the excess paper into the bottom of the tube to hold the candy in.

With the sharpie, draw a rounded small square in the center of the tube, then a larger one beneath it all the way to the bottom edge.

On the opposite side, write your name in glue and draw a few snowflakes around it. Sprinkle glitter over the glue and allow to dry.

On the extra white paper, draw (or print out) the face and cut out carefully. Wrap the orange pipe cleaner tightly around the tip of a pen or pencil to make the carrot shape. Glue two google eyes and nose to the face.

Olaf Inspired Treat Kolder



Run a string of glue from the small rounded square to the top end of the tube and glue the head on the body.

Glue 3 leaf stems in a cluster behind the face on the tube so that they poke out above the head. Attach the larger sticks to the sides of the body with hot glue and glue the three black pom pons to the body.

Glue the two larger white pom pons on the left and right side of the bottom part of the body. Fill with candy and give to a friend!
