

What you will need

- Template
- Hot Glue Gun
- Scissors
- Sock (Beige)
- 9" x 11" Felt Sheet (Brown & Pink)
- Googly Eyes
- Pom Pom (Black)
- Craft Foam Paper (Pink)
- Cardboard

Let's Get Creative!

- 1 Using the template, trace and cut out the mouth on both cardboard and on the Pink felt. Fold the cardboard mouth piece in half and insert into the end of the sock all the way to the toe. Cut the seam and add drops of glue inside the seam and press down to glue the sock to the the cardboard mouth. Then, glue the Pink mouth piece over the mouth area to form the inside of the mouth.
- 2 Using the Brown felt, trace and cut out 4 large ear pieces. Glue the felt ear pieces to each side of the 2 cardboard ears. Using the small ear template, trace and cut out the smaller ears on the Pink felt and glue to the center of the larger ears.
- 3 Fold the mouth of the puppet closed and glue the ear pieces to the top of the folded edge. Be sure you don't glue the sock to the cardboard on the folded edge. This will keep your fingers from fitting inside the head of the puppet.
- 4 Using the mask template, trace and cut out the eye mask. Then, along the long sides, cut small slits to make the hair/fur. Glue the mask halfway between the ears and the front end of the head, then glue the googly eyes onto the mask.
- 5 Glue a Black pom om on the front end of the head to make the nose.
- 6 Using the template and Brown felt, trace and cut out the Ferret's coat and glue to the back of the ferret. Be sure to place the coat all the way up to the ears with curved portion between the ears.
