

Paperplate Aquarium



What you will need

- □ 2 Paper Plates
- □ Colored Construction Paper
- □ Cereal
- □ Googly Eyes
- □ Acrylic Paint
- □ Paint Brushes
- □ White Glue
- □ Craft Materials like colorful beads, fuzzy sticks, pom poms, etc.

Let's Get Creative!

- Prepare paper plates: If you're using a white plate, paint the inside of one plate blue. You can find blue plates in the party section of most big box stores.
- Use a pair of scissors or a craft knife to cut out the inside circle of the other paper plate.
- Craft some sea creatures and plants from colorful construction paper. You can make a jellyfish or seaweeds with pom poms and fuzzy sticks.
- Glue beads, cereals, shells to the bottom edge of the plate, overlapping the plants, to create a sea floor and craft the background.
- Hot glue the sea creatures you made onto the background, dont forget to add the googly eyes and keep in mind to steer clear of the outside edges of the plate that will be covered up in the next step.
- Cut the center out of the second paper plate and glue it to the front of the aquarium.
