

Preserve an animal track and take the wilderness home with you!

What you will need

- Plaster of Paris
- Water
- Can
- Stirring stick
- Carboard strip
- Paper clip

Let's get creative

Preparation Notes.

When you've found a good animal track you'd like to preserve, clean the area around it from any excess dirt and twigs.

Make a ring around the track with a 1 inch strip of cardboard. Fasten the ends together witht the paper clip.

In the can, mix the plaster and water according to the package's instructions. Stir well. Pour immediately first around the edges of the ring, then into the animal track.

Allow plaster to harden for about an hour, then peel off the cardboard collar. Wash off any residual dirt.
