What you will need

- ☐ Toilet Paper Roll
- □ Paint and Brushes
- ☐ Googley Eyes
- ☐ Glue
- ☐ Tissue Paper
- Twine
- Scissors

Let's Get Creative!

- Paint your toilet paper roll and set aside to dry. Once dry, draw fish scales on the TP roll with a marker.
- 2 Cut 2 tissue paper strips, one shorter than the other. Fold the tissue paper pieces in half.
- Glue the larger strip of tissue paper inside the TP roll to form the tail. The shorter strip will be glued to the outiside of the roll to form the back fin.
- Glue the eyes above the back fin.

At the top of the fish, glue the ends of the twine inside the paper roll and tie to make a hanging loop.
