

PAPER PLATE TAMBOURINE


The Youth Leader's Resource for Fun Patches and other great things!

What you will need

- ☐ Two paper plates
- □ Five jingle bells (¾" or 1")
- □ Hole punch
- □ Pipe cleaner or twist ties
- □ Acrylic Paint
- □ Paint brushes
- □ White glue
- □ Craft Materials like stickers, glitter, sequins etc.

Let's Get Creative!

- Punch holes on the paper plates. Place two small paper plates together and align them at the edges. While keeping both plates aligned, punch five evenly spaced holes around the plate. You can mark their positions with a pencil prior to making the holes.
- Paint the back side of each paper plate and set aside to dry.
- Decorate the paper plates using materials you already have like stickers, sequins, glitter, etc.
- Prepare five jingle bells as well as five twist ties or cut
 2-inch long pipe cleaner pieces. String a jingle bell through
 the middle of each twist tie or pipe cleaner. Bend the ends
 of the twist tie or pipe cleaner towards each other.
- Put the plates together—the unpainted side should be on the inside and the decorated side on the outside. Position the plates so that the holes are in exact alignment and the edges are aligned as well.
- Attach the first jingle bell to your paper plate tambourine. Twist the ends of the pipe cleaner or twist tie around one of the pairs of holes on the tambourine.
- Attach the other bells. Similarly attach the four remaining bells around the other four pairs of holes on the tambourine.
